Youth Worker (Heritage Focus)

Rousay, Egilsay & Wyre Development Trust has secured funding from the North Isles Landscape Partnership Scheme (NILPS) to employ 2 Youth Workers.

The two Youth Workers will plan and deliver short, regular Youth Club sessions for young people in the local community in a relaxed and informal way with a positive group atmosphere.

The successful applicants will support young people in developing self esteem; self confidence, social relationships and help to widen their horizons.

The Youth Workers and young people will work together to develop a heritage-related project inspired by their island. Heritage-related could mean, e.g. traditional skills, culture, arts, history, archaeology, and landscape etc.

This role is short-term between Autumn 2022 and Spring 2023
(28 weeks – four hours per week + 16 hours training and planning)
